

## NO REGRETS

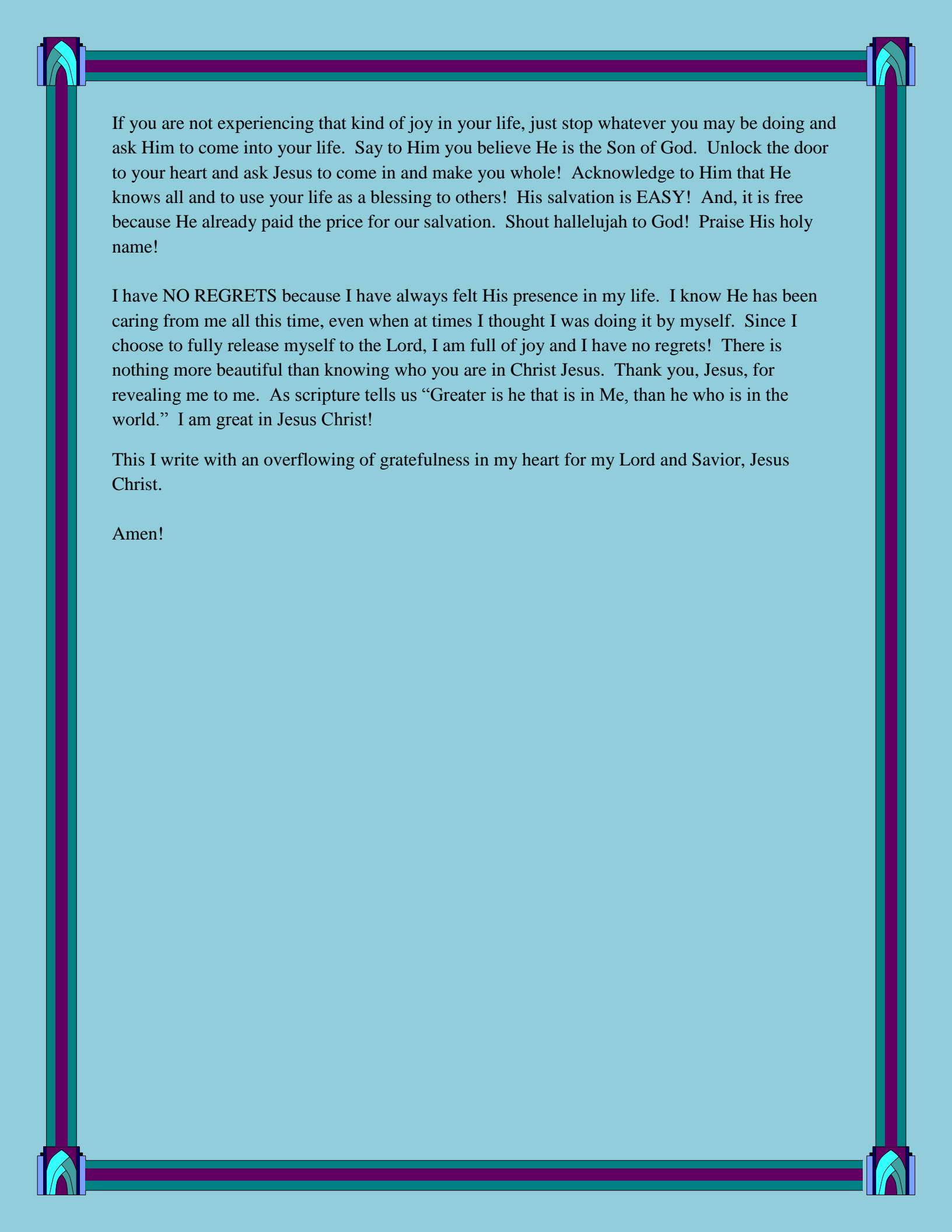
You go through a lot of things in life to get where you're going. However, if you look back and realize that while you were going through the things, you should also realize that without going through them, you would not be where you are at now.
